Rules

Two dice must be rolled at the same time

Start in the UK

Travel the number of spaces defined by the dice. You don't have to make

the full journey in one go

Collect 4 animals from around the world

Use the routes mapped out with journey times

You can move multiple animals only if you have enough food and water

otherwise you risk losing the animal

* At each location when carrying an animal you must re-roll the dice to check you have enough food and water for the animal - the amount required will be stated on the animal card

The animal card must be left behind if not enough is rolled on

the dice. Another player may pick the animal up if they go to

that location as part of their turn. The animal card is left face-up

* The game starts with animal cards located at animal pickup points around the board and these are face down initially

* The person who gets back to the UK with 4 animals and enough food and water, wins. The game finishes when all players complete their collection of 4 animals and return to the UK
